**Instructions:** Each dot between numerical values represents 1 full stop. You must count the total number of stops (dots) when adjusting any one or two of the 3 settings (f-stop, shutter speed, or ISO) in any direction (more or less). You then need to adjust one or both of the other settings in the opposite direction totaling the same number of stops (dots) to maintain the correct exposure.
